

# Mukta Arts Ltd AGM Presentation

Year in Review



### Year in Review


- The company showed some areas of improvement across all its businesses in the past 12 months
- Revenues up as well as footfalls for Mukta A2 Cinemas as compared to the previous year
- Mukta A2 Cinemas has seen a strong uptick in business in summer 2023
- Mukta Arts standalone saw a 25% profit on revenues after taxes for the year
- Mukta Arts launched its TV Series 'Janaki' on DD to excellent feedback
- WWI saw increased student intake, hitting pre-pandemic numbers
- WWI land case continuing but a resolution seems much closer



#### Mukta A2 Cinemas

- Mukta A2 Cinemas saw its footfalls increase from 1.7 million to over 4 million in the past 12 months
- Revenues also up in India and Bahrain, growing over 200% from the previous year
- The company opened a location in Chittorgarh, Rajasthan and exited loss-making properties
- Since July 2023, the performance of theatres has been record-breaking with the company twice breaking all time records in collections and F&B
- Pipeline for the coming year looks strong with engaging content
- Ad revenues have also gradually returned to near normal levels
- Mukta A2 has signed an MoU to create a chain of theatres in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia on a management basis






#### Mukta Arts Productions

- Mukta Arts started shooting its series 'Janaki' for Doordarshan and the show premiered on August 15 to excellent reviews
- The show has already been approved for its full run of 208 episodes
- In addition, three new films are proposed for the coming year including 'Salakhen' starring Jackie Shroff and Mezwan Jaffrey
- Discussions are on with studio partners for the upcoming slate which includes 'Chor Police' and 'Khalnayak Returns'.
- The Marathi film 'Tu Mi Ani Amaira' is also ready for release in the coming months
- Conversations are also ongoing with various streaming services for a range of series projects











### Whistling Woods International

- WWI has had a good intake of students, back to pre-pandemic levels
- Over 450 students were recruited in July 2023 taking the total count of students on the campus to back over 1100
- WWI has signed major affiliations partnerships with international universities including Queen Mary University, London, University of the Arts, London, Toronto Metropolitan University and several others
- WWI also signed an agreement with gaming giant Ubisoft and became the authorized partner of Epic Games' Unreal Engine
- The WWI land issue also seems to be coming to a conclusion with hearings resuming and therefore hope of a positive outcome in a short time-frame

## Way Ahead

- Mukta A2 Cinemas will continue to ride the positive wave of box office performance and strengthen its offering across properties
- Saudi deal should bring additional value to the bottom line without investment
- New cinema openings are planned
- 'Janaki' Production will continue until Feb 2024 which should strengthen the company's profitability significantly
- Film Production will resume in 2024 with a Studio partner for the three films in development to ensure risk is adequately mitigated
- WWI will continue to focus on emerging media and immersive technology to build toward new course offerings
- WWI land case resolution, if it happens this financial year, could lead to significant upside for the company and shareholders
